

## Marking the canal orifices with FLOW-COLOR composite

■ Patients often struggle with more serious dental ailments, such as extensive cavities. They often require endodontic intervention that we did not plan in advance. We must then properly prepare the treated teeth for subsequent endodontic treatment and protect them until the patient's next visit.








■ We carefully prepare the tooth and remove all tissues affected by caries. In such procedures, it may turn out that the caries also covers the pulp, which requires us to also treat the infected soft tissues of the tooth. The above situations often occur during shorter visits, when we do not have enough time to properly and meticulously prepare and fill the canals. Then we should mark and secure their outlets to make it easier and shorter for ourselves at the next visit.







A colored "flow" composite, which is always at hand, is ideal for such a procedure. It facilitates diagnostics during re-treatment of the tooth. A wide range of available colors can improve the organization of our work, thanks to conscientious adherence to marking specific cases with a given color. The most important thing is that the use of the product is quick and functional for us.







■ After using FLOW-COLOR, when reopening the tooth, the continuation of the treatment will be much faster, and our work more effective. FLOW-COLOR can also be used as a differentiating layer under temporary restorations after endodontic treatment. This quick step will protect your patient's teeth from later over-preparation, so you will save your patient time spent in the chair and gain their gratitude and trust.
