- Missing teeth in the aesthetic part of the jaw are a significant problem among dental patients. Neglect of hygiene and injuries cause tooth loss, which results in serious complexes and a lack of desire to smile in people affected by this problem.

- In the case of this Patient, the use of COMCORD was proposed to create a combined adhesive restoration.
- The patient will be able to enjoy a dazzling smile after just one visit!








■ Before starting work, it is necessary to prepare carious tissues and then etch these surfaces thoroughly. ETCHGEL etches enamel for 30 seconds and dentine for 10 seconds. Rinse thoroughly, dry and cover with the MASTERBOND bonding system to create COMCORD adhesion with tooth tissues. Such preparation of the work area will provide us with comfort of work and significantly extend the durability of the adhesive restoration.









- After appropriate preparation of the areas prepared in the arch using COMCORD, we make a ring-shaped front teeth base.
- After its polymerization, we rebuild the missing parts of the teeth using CREATE composite.
- Teeth reinforced in this way are resistant to forces much stronger than chewing forces.









- After calcifying and adjusting the teeth in the bite, it is time to give the work a shine. We do this step using GLAZE.
- Its use saves a lot of time on mechanical polishing of the work and thanks to the shine it visually rejuvenates the smile.
- The final effect of the aesthetic and durable work reinforced with COMCORD.
